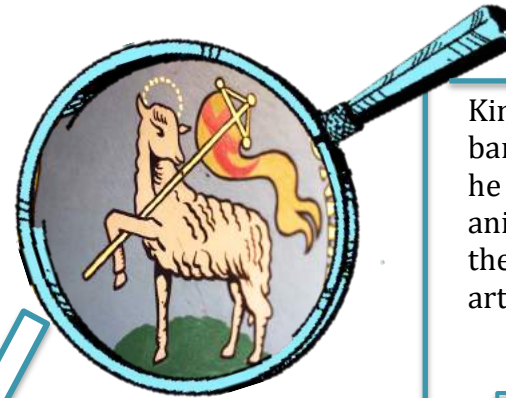


King Edmund's hidden artefacts
